

If your Outlook data file becomes large, fragmented, slow, or cumbersome you may need to


compact it. Useful if you have been deleting or moving a lot of data within your data file about.

The compacting technique differs from system to system, so this technique is specifically for Hosted Exchange or IMAP email accounts.

- 1 Load Outlook.
- 2 Right mouse click the datafile and select 'Data File Properties'.



- 3 Select Advanced.
- 4 Select advanced and press 'OK'.



5 – Select 'Outlook Data File Settings' and press 'OK'.

6 – finally, Select 'Compact Now' and press 'OK'.
